Initial training (Judicial Institute Diploma) three years at JIJ after the first or second or third degree in law, candidate must pass the JIJ exams and have one year of training at courts.



Continuous training for judges, prosecutors.

- Training for Ministry of Justice staff members.
- Other governmental staff (on demand).

Besides, JIJ organize seminars, conferences and similar activities in the field of judicial and law issues in cooperation with Ministry of justice , Judicial Council and stakeholders.
